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Sd card suddenly unreadable android

Sd card unreadable windows 10.

I have looked through other forums but wanted to post a thread with the exact symptoms. Last night my phone just stopped recognizing my Micro SD card which unfortunately had some important data on it. I tried the card on other devices and it is not recognized either. It looks like the map didn't even exist. At this point I could probably contact Samsung or SanDisk and get a replacement card, but getting the data is essential. Is there any program or method I can use to get data from the card even if it is not recognized? I don't have access to an SD card reader, but I could grab one if needed.



Currently connecting the phone to the computer does not show the map as present at all, let alone read data. Any advice is appreciated. I had the same thing happen to me about a month ago. The card randomly says "Exiled, safe removal" or something. I removed the card and none of my 3 computers will read the card. He didn't make any mistakes, he just didn't do anything like he didn't exist. All I cared about was the pictures, so I tried 3 different adapters and it still didn't work. I cleaned the contacts with alcohol (watch out for the Q-TIP) and inserted the adapter into the reader, then the Micro SD card. After about a dozen insertions/deletions, finally read the stupid log. I extracted the photos and did a full windows reformat (quick format), scanned for damaged blocks and reformatted after putting it back on the phone. I set Google to automatically back up my photos to G+.

Not since, but I certainly wouldn't trust my SD card with something that can't be easily replaced or isn't regularly backed up. 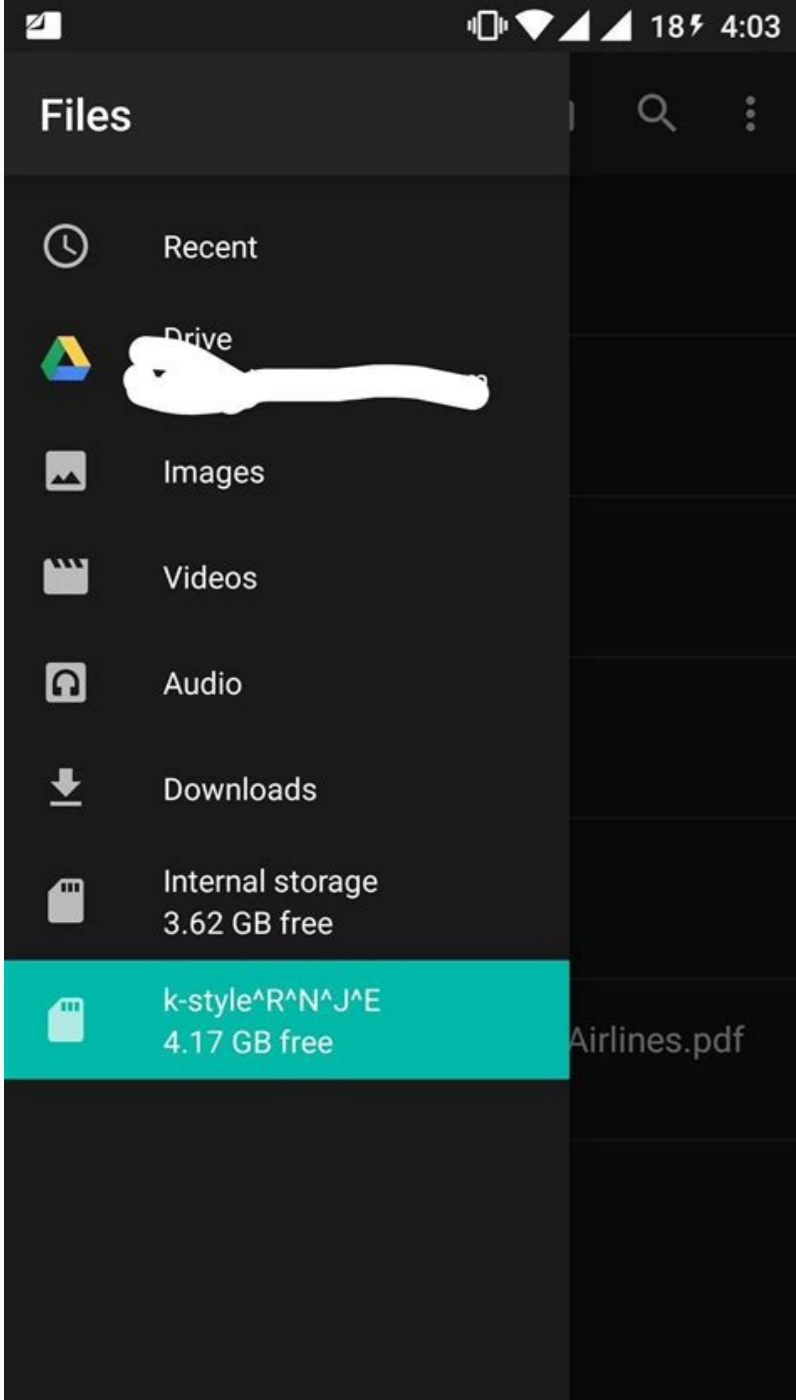
My card didn't show up at all on one of my laptops and the phone showed up as a blank SD card. Step 1 You can try to solve this by using the Windows Integrated Chkdsk utility on the desktop. Open an input prompt (start->execute->cmd.exe) and type chkdsk /x /f /r /y my sd card. Fix and follow instructions otherwise it may say chkdsk not available for raw files (this is a message I don't need to worry about (freeware) One in block C: and open C:\TestDisk 7.0 -WIP> Right click click "Testisk_win.exe" and select as administrator. The program should not be installed. This can take time, even hours, depending on the size of the SD card.



So be patient. A. Select "Register in the first window" and press Enter. B. Select the OU to analyze, select Drive and press Enter. C. Select partition type - option 2 - EFI GPT and press D. in "Analysis" with send to force. The device/partition will be analyzed. E. Confirm under "Quick Inquiry" with shipping.

I added my thread for informational purposes, but I'll check it tomorrow and update how the method was going.
