

For a third consecutive season, the Los Angeles Dodgers were not represented on the list of the top 10 MLB Network's leading launchers. Shredder looked at a two-year sample for prominent launchers when determining its 2021 charts, but weighed this past season heavier. The new Chicago White Sox nearest Liam Hendriks claimed first place for 2021, after a two-year dominant with the Oakland Athletics. The right was the most valuable coach in baseball, accumulating 5.2 WAR (FanGraphs) while posting an ERA 1.66 out of 97 games. The rest of the list, in order, consists of Drew Pomeranz, Devin Williams, Nick Anderson, James Karinchak, Brad Hand, Aroldis Chapman, Aaron Bummer, Tyler Duffey and Josh Hader. Only Hendricks, Chapman and Hader appeared in The Shredder 2020. MLB Network analysts Sarah Langs and Mike Petriello both had Hendricks, Chapman and Hader appeared in The Shredder, it is worth noting that their bullpen was among the best in the previous season. The unit finished third in FanGraphs' WAR (3.5,) chasing only Tampa Bay Rays and Minnesota Twins (3.6 each). Jake McGee, who is now a free agent, led the bullpen Dodgers with 0.7 WAR last season, posting a 2.66 ERA in 20.1 innings. Other standouts include Victor Gonzalez, who posted a 1.40 ERA as a rookie; and Adam Kolarek, whose 0.95 ERA was the lowest among L.A lifts with a minimum of 15 innings launched. The dodgers bullpen suffered a bit of a makeover this offseason, with Corey Knebel, Tommy Kahnle and Brandon Morrow among the new additions. Blake Treinen was resigned, but the club is still looking for another highleverage and could try to add Hand, which would help to strengthen the closest role. In response, some teams have allocated funds and traded to create a "super bullpen", however this is not a successful guarantee since the execution of rescue launchers was shown to float much more wildly than start launchers. For example, the Cleveland 2016 and 2017 Indians had the strongest league bullpen, however their bullpen in 2018 fought and the Indians won their division thanks to the strength of their initial rotation.
